Thank you for entering VIP Dog Sports April UKI Trial, which will be held April 18 & 19, 2026 with our judge Karen Albert from Maryland. We sincerely appreciate your support!

A general briefing will be given after measuring and check-in.

Important:

- **Please bring a second pair of shoes, ONLY CLEAN Shoes on turf. We suggest a slip-on shoe for outside use and your running shoes for the turf. If it rains or the ground is wet from dew we ask that you do not track mud from your shoes or your dogs feet into the arena. Please also have a towel to wipe your dog's feet – you do not want your dog to have wet feet for the turf or running in tunnels as it can be hard on their pads.**
- **We will be starting at 9:00am!**
  - **Judging starts at 9:00am.**
  - **Arena opens at 8:00am, with a briefing at 8:30.**
  - **Walkthrough at 8:40am**
- **Measuring:**
  - A 1st measure must be obtained and sent to the UKI office by the dog's 3rd trial. A measurement from another organization may be used for this measure if it is an actual measurement and is not within .25" (6mm) of a jump height cut off.
  - A 2nd measure must be obtained between 12 months and by a maximum of 18 months after the dog's 1st recorded measurement.
  - If the dog is age three or over, the dog will only need one measure and this must be taken by a UKI measurer.
  - In summary, to receive a permanent jump height measurement: If the 1st measure is on a dog under 3 years old, the dog must be measured by a UKI official 12-18 months after their 1st measurement. Or the dog is a minimum of three years old at their 1st measure.

- The weather is going to be HOT for Saturday with highs near 90. We should be back to comfortable lower 70's on Sunday. Remember to bring your fans for your dog! We will have a hose and a kiddie pool available to help cool your dogs.
- Lunch Break: We will take a lunch break each day. Listen for announcements as to when we will take it.
- Day of show entries will be allowed - you may add additional runs. Please bring cash for add-on runs:
  - \$18 / Regular run
  - \$38 / Masters Series
- Make sure the information in your confirmation is correct.
- Move-ups: please get them in by Friday April 17th .
- Move ups from Saturday to Sunday – need to be submitted within 30 min after the last dog runs on Saturday.
- If you Owe money please bring check or cash with you and see Katelyn Scott to pay
- RVs & Campers may arrive Friday – if the chain is across the drive when you arrive, you can just unhook that and come in. Please replace the chain if you take it down. RV Parking as outlined below but you can also call/text Greg if you have question about where to park (719) 648.9311
- See the map/drawing at the end of this confirmation for where to park cars and RVs. Don't park so that someone else is blocked in please.
- Parking area right in front of the arena is for loading/off-loading/Judge Only. This is where we setup practice jumps.
- There is crating space available in the arena in an appx. 40x100 area. You can also crate out of your vehicle but please be aware of the heat. If you crate in the arena please bring a mat or tarp to put under your crate. We will have some crates available for arena crating (they will be marked with an Available sign).
- Maps will be posted at the arena for you to take pictures, and will also be available online at VIP's website here on the day of the show:

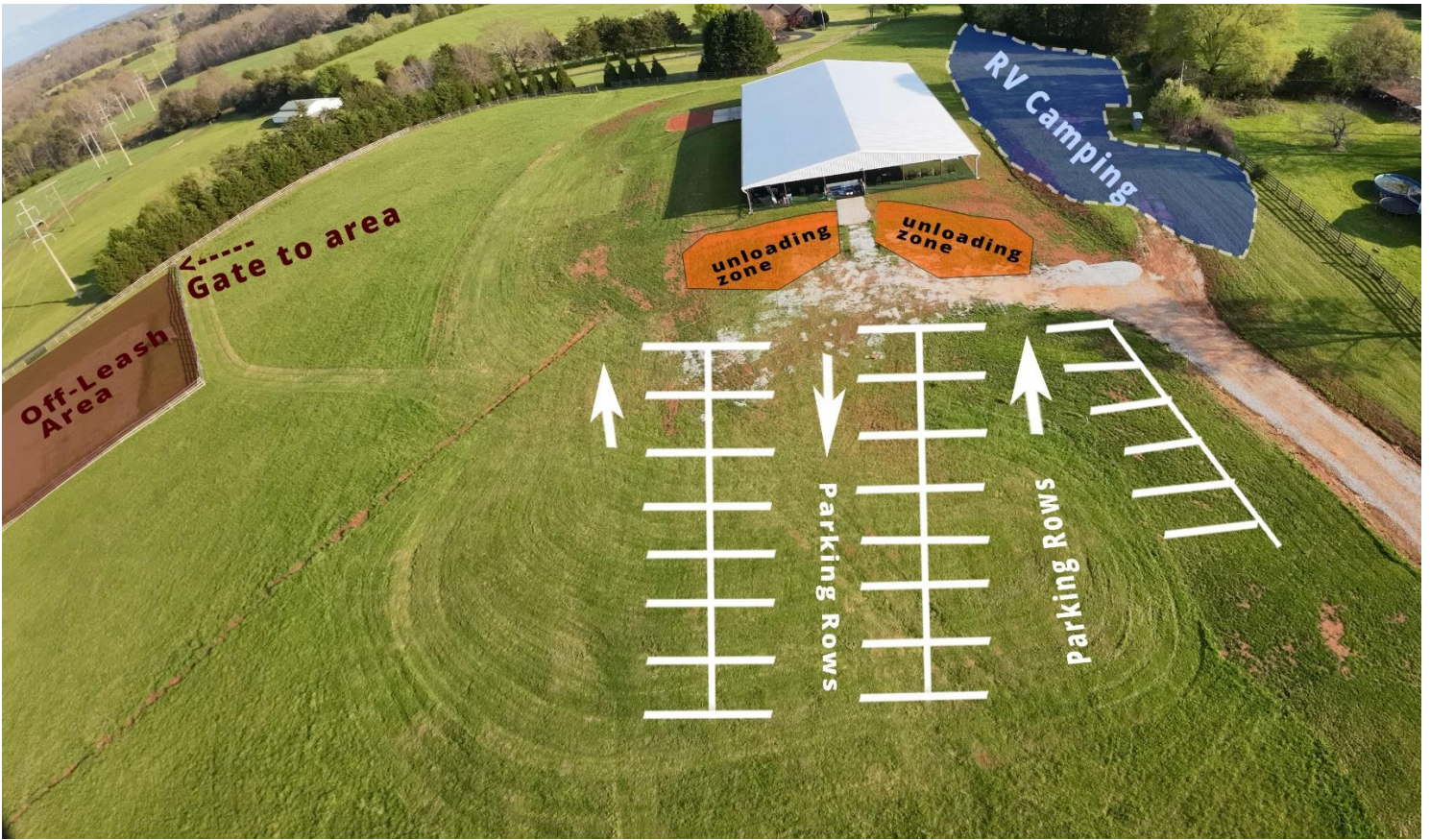

#### TRIAL RULES

- This is a **No Smoking** property. Thank you for understanding.
- Dogs must be on leash or under voice control at all times.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs anywhere on the property.
- RV parking will be to the right of the arena, up the incline from the drive.
- Cars will park in the grass in front of the arena. There is plenty of space.
- We are offering our off-leash private dog park for you to play on / exercise your dogs. There is an entrance gate at the far corner (see map below).



For RVs, the most level parking is on either side of the porta-potties.
